SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility: Eligibility is limited to law students who are currently enrolled at an accredited law school in full-time or part-time programs at the time of application and award. Scholarship applicant finalists will participate in a virtual interview as part of the application process. One scholarship in the amount of \$2,000.00 may be awarded each calendar year. The scholarship recipient will present a five-minute speech at the annual APABA South Florida Scholarship and Awards Gala detailing how the scholarship helped the recipient learn about Judge Sasser.

Please provide truthful answers to the application questions. APABA South Florida will maintain in confidence all information received from and about applicants.

Selection Criteria: Preference will be given to candidates who *both* (a) are active members of their local APALSA chapter (or equivalent) or any APABA organization (or equivalent); and (b) intend to practice law in the South Florida area and become active members of APABA South Florida. APABA South Florida may consider financial need, community service, academic achievement, and other factors in selecting the scholarship recipient.
